An almost identical pair of tables was sold from the collection of Lily and Edmond J. Safra, Sotheby's New York, 18th - 21st October 2011, lot 1080 (\$31,250)

These rare tables were possibly originally intended to carry tea caddies, tea-urns or work-boxes as caddies and work-boxes in this technique exist and the tables were possibly also therefore made by box-makers of the day. The red "Morocco leather" paper on the underside being the same as that used by the makers of tea caddies and work boxes to line the lids and undersides.

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
